RENEWALS

Materials, except items with outstanding requests, may be renewed up to 8 times, unless an item has outstanding requests. The renewal period will be the same as that for which the item was originally checked out and will start with the day the item is renewed. Materials may be renewed in person at any library or by:

ON-LINE RENEWAL

Renew online at collierlibrary.org. Select the "My Account" link. Your library account can be accessed using your name and library card

TELEPHONE RENEWAL

Renew by telephone using the library's automated renewal line at 239-920-7474. You will need to have your library card number available for telephone renewal.

RETURNING MATERIALS

Card owner assumes responsibility for all materials borrowed on their card. **Due dates are on your receipt.** Materials can be returned to any Collier County library.



REGISTRATION

Library cards are free to all permanent residents and real property owners of Collier County. Valid photo identification AND proof of residency must be presented in person to apply for, renew or replace a library card. The following items with your current Collier County street address will be accepted as proof of residency:

- Driver's license
- Collier County Property Tax Receipt
- Check with imprinted name & address
- Mortgage/annual lease agreement
- Your telephone listing with address
- Property Deed
- Utility Bill
- Vehicle Registration
- Florida ID Card
- Voter Registration Card

LIBRARY CARDS

RESIDENT CARDS

No fee is charged for the initial library card. Library cards are valid for three (3) years. A \$1 fee is assessed to replace a damaged or lost card.

CHILDREN'S CARDS

A child is eligible for a library card at birth, but must be present in the library to receive their card. A parent or legal guardian's permission and proof of residency is required for a minor (under 16) to obtain a library card.

NON-RESIDENT CARDS

Library cards are available to Collier County visitors for a fee of \$10 per month or \$50 for six months. Valid photo identification with permanent home address is required; local address may be confirmed verbally.

TO PROTECT YOUR PRIVACY

A card owner must immediately notify the library:

- If the card is lost/stolen.
- Of address, telephone, e-mail or name changes.

Card must be presented to borrow materials. Card owner assumes responsibility for all materials borrowed on his/her card.

Note: Florida Statute 257.261 prohibits staff from releasing any information except to the specific card owner. This includes personal information as well as materials charged to the record.

RESERVING ITEMS

RESERVED MATERIALS

- Can be requested online, in person, or by telephone.
- Are limited to 10 items at one time.
- Reserves are held for five business days.

Patrons will be notified by email or phone when reserved items are available for pick-up. Please bring the library card on which the items were requested.

SPECIAL SERVICES

INTERLIBRARY LOAN SERVICES

Books and magazine articles not owned by the library can be borrowed through Interlibrary Loan. Information is available at collierlibrary.org under Library Services or at any library.

MAIL-A-BOOK: LIBRARY SERVICES FOR THE HOMEBOUND

The Library mails library materials to qualified patrons who are homebound and unable to come into a library. Contact Mail-a-Book at 239-252-7372 for an application.

GENEALOGY SERVICES

Naples Regional Library houses a genealogy collection and resources. Genealogy databases are available online through the Library.

YOUTH SERVICES Children and Young Adult services are available at all library locations.

- The library recommends that children through the age of seven (7) years have a parent, guardian, or responsible caregiver in the immediate vicinity of and in direct visual contact with the child.
- Parents, guardians and caregivers are responsible for the behavior and well-being of their children.
- Children of any age who are unable or unwilling to care for themselves may not be left alone in the library and must have adequate supervision while in the library.

COMPUTER RELATED SERVICES

COMPUTER ACCESS

Public computers with access to the internet and Microsoft Office are offered at all libraries for free to valid library card owners. Library card must be presented to obtain computer access.

WEB ACCESS

Visit the Library online at collierlibrary.org to use the library catalog or take advantage of the many electronic resources provided. By using your name and library card number you can also check your account, renew items, reserve materials, and cancel reserves.
